A turning point came when Sakshi received a tablet from NDDP in Class 10th. This enabled her to access online career counselling which sparked her interest in law. Also, the mental health sessions helped her to improve herself.

The mental health sessions were very effective for Sakshi. The sessions helped her to stabilize her emotions. Before that, she was very sensitive and not able to handle her emotions properly. She shared "I prefer solitude over being in a group."
