Foreword

As we reflect on Newgen's CSR journey for 2023-2024, I am immensely excited to witness the range of activities we were able to execute during the financial year. The CSR program, which was initiated in 2014, completed a decade this year. As we continue to work passionately, we look forward to adding many more years of sustainable changes to the various sections of the less-privileged society.

Newgen Digital Discovery Paathshala

(NDDP) continues to be the core of our CSR program with the inclusion of a fresh approach to hybrid sessions (online and offline) to be at par with the current scenario. This approach gave a massive push to the program, and we were able to achieve the outcome much faster.

As part of our CSR endeavors to reinvent and give better education to its beneficiaries, this year, we made an active attempt to educate the students about science. With the introduction to science in the adopted schools for the senior classes, we found it necessary to include the subject in our program and NDDP sessions and build a wealth of knowledge around the topic. This indirectly influenced the inculcation of analytical, observational and logical skills in the students.



We're embracing the digital frontier.

A training session on Lego robotics was introduced at the annual CSR Week, which gave Newgen employees an opportunity to interact with the students and engage in robot-making and coding. Later, this session also became a part of the STEM summer camps. The counselling sessions also included detailed discussions around developments in science.

At the beginning of 2023, we initiated our community outreach by visiting homes and understanding the demography and needs of the beneficiaries' families, especially mothers. On analyzing the survey, we started involving the mothers of the beneficiaries in a few interventions. At first, a digital summer camp for the daughter-mother duos was organized. It was followed by skill development sessions for the mothers, where they used knitting material to create beautiful handicraft products like mats, coasters, door hangings, and other decorative items. These materials were sold during exhibitions in Newgen offices and gave the NDDP mothers a sense of confidence and showed them an opportunity for income generation. Meanwhile, to help these women psychologically, IAm - our mental wellbeing partner - created awareness around mental health. A simple interaction with these mothers helped the NDDP's prime stakeholder add a new page to our program.

Another new addition was introducing the life-skill development program for the junior batch of NDDP (Class 6 to 8). This new program helped focus on laying the foundation for building a well-groomed personality for our students.

This year, we also witnessed the second batch of NDDP Alumni graduate Class 12 with flying colors and opt for higher education. The students were guided throughout the admission process, and educational scholarships were organized for the meritorious ones. Currently, a total of 100+ NDDP alumni are pursuing their higher education.

We continued distributing tablets and recharged data cards this year and digitally empowered over 2,500 students. These devices served as an additional educational tool to help the students connect with the digital world and aid their digital literacy.

Furthermore, Newgen's implementation partners continued their commendable work during the year and helped us reach the remote areas. The Akshaya Patra
Foundation provided healthy and nutritious mid-day meals to children. Over 10 lakh mid-day meals were fed to more than 4,800 students. We expanded also our reach in Nathdwara, Jodhpur, and Baran in Rajasthan, Gorakhpur in Uttar Pradesh, Bhilai in Chhattisgarh, Mangalagiri in Andhra Pradesh and Mysore in Karnataka. This year, the CSR team visited one of the kitchens and witnessed the meticulous process of meal preparation and packing.

KHUSHII's remedial education program reached over 6,500 students in Harkesh Nagar and Tekhand (Delhi), Nandambakkam (Chennai), and Ramgarh (Uttarakhand). KK Academy continued to offer holistic development to the less privileged children in Lucknow and their inclusive learning environment benefitted 240 students.

IAm Wellbeing introduced the life skills development session to NDDP students (Class 6 to 8) this year. Additionally, the personality development sessions for all NDDP students till Class 12 included a range of topics on self-esteem, communication, emotion management, and mental health awareness. A new program was initiated for the mothers of NDDP students, and IAm came on board to guide them in handling their mental wellbeing.






The aspiring women are taught knitting, embroidery, crochet, etc. at the Skill Development Centre.




