NDDP Senior Students Foster Class VI Inclusion

Each year, the **Newgen Digital Discovery Paathshala** (NDDP) program welcomes a new batch of grade six students to its initiative. Designed to enhance digital literacy and critical thinking, the NDDP sessions offer an interactive learning environment to empower students with essential skills.

For the 2024 batch, the NDDP introduced a new approach to boost enrolment, with the following steps:

- Leveraging Senior Students: The program reached out to senior NDDP students from classes VII to XII. These students serve as peer influencers who can help create a trustworthy connection with potential enrollees by sharing their positive experiences and benefits of the program with younger students.
- In-person Interactions: To further build trust and rapport, both students and mothers were invited to meet in person with the NDDP facilitators. These interactions allowed families to gain insights into the program and build a personal connection with the facilitator.

Positive Impact

As a result of this new approach, the NDDP program witnessed a gradual rise in enrollment. The feedback from the students highlights their enjoyment of the audio-visual materials used during the sessions. The visuals enhanced the learning experience by making it easier for them to understand complex topics such as the Panchayati Raj and Discrimination. The sessions on subjects beyond the regular curriculum proved to be particularly informative, with "The Seven Wonders of the World" being a clear favorite for most.
