2 Release summary

The NewgenONE OmniDocs Mobile app has been completely rebuilt using Flutter, providing a seamless and visually appealing experience for both Android and iOS users. The revamped user interface of the app is designed for intuitive navigation. It now includes offline support, enabling access to certain functionalities without an internet connection. This update significantly improves the user experience.

Additionally, a microservices-based server component has been introduced for OmniDocs mobile, enhancing the user experience by providing APIs specifically designed for mobile devices.

2.1 New features and enhancements

The following tables list the new features of the NewgenONE OmniDocs Mobile 11.3 release:

Feature	Description
Login	All sign-in functionalities are supported, including changing passwords and resetting forgotten passwords. Users can sign in to the app with MPIN, fingerprint, or face ID and have the option to change their MPIN.
Repository operations - Folder	The following operations can be performed on a folder: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mark/remove favorites• View/edit properties• Delete• Move/copy• Share and more
Repository operations - Document	The following operations can be performed on folders and documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mark and remove favorites• View and edit properties• check-in and checkout• Delete• Move and copy• Share• Linking documents• Duplicate documents and more
Advanced camera support	The advanced mobile camera support offers features like perspective correction and binarization.
Offline support	Users can perform the following operations within the app even when offline or unable to connect to the NewgenONE OmniDocs server: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Save documents for offline viewing• Add documents to a designated offline folder for access without an internet connection• Create cases as a creator in OmniProcess for both folder and document processes

Feature	Description
OmniProcess operations - Maker and checker	Capability to create and process OmniProcess instruments for maker and checker, including actions like submission, data editing, and advancing or returning steps."
User Profile	Users can access and modify their profiles, including actions such as changing their MPIN or password.
